

HOLY TRINITY YOUNG MEN'S SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM OVERVIEW

SCHOLARSHIP MISSION STATEMENT: To support all Holy Trinity male members that are graduated high school Seniors in their personal, academic and spiritual journeys by offering financial, professional and spiritual guidance in the form of a multi-year scholarship program

REQUIREMENTS FOR CONSIDERATION:

- Must be Confirmed Member of HTLC
- Must be HTLC Member for at least two (2) years prior to application
- Must have attended at least ten (10) Youth meetings during Senior year of High School (attendance subject to confirmation by Director of Youth Ministry)
- Must have a specific College or Technical School to which they have been accepted (copy of letter of acceptance required)
- Commitment to update BOT membership on their personal and academic progress after each semester
- Other requirements

CRITERIA FOR SCHOLARSHIP AWARD:

- Must meet all Requirements for Consideration
- Must be male in gender and identify themselves as a male in gender
- Must be high school graduate (copy of high school diploma required)
- No financial need has to be demonstrated to qualify

SELECTION PROCESS:

- Submit application and essay (essay topic TBD)
- Application reviewed by BOT Scholarship Committee (committee members TBD)
- Applicants attend a face-to-face discussion with Scholarship Committee members
- Scholarships are awarded and checks delivered no later than August 1st of every school year

SCHOLARSHIP ATTRIBUTES:

- \$500.00 to be used as needed by scholarship recipient for expenses incurred while pursuing their college degree or technical certification
- Maximum four (4) year financial commitment subject to verification that recipient is enrolled and in academic good-standing
- BOT Member assigned as Mentor to support recipient personally, academically and spiritually (Mentor assignment driven by but not limited to things like: field of study, career aspirations, school choice, family background, etc.)
- Recipient is recognized as member in good-standing of the Holy Trinity Bible on Tap Men's Ministry

SCHOLARSHIP FUNDING:

- Follow funding guidelines provided to us by Derek Peterson at Thrivent Financial
- Create at least three (3) fundraising events per year to fund scholarships (e.g., Oktoberfest, annual BOT Pub Crawl, etc.)
- Short-term goal is to fund immediate scholarships, long-term goal is to create endowment (>\$25,000)
